Having heard learned Senior Counsel appearing for the parties and upon perusal of the record, we are not inclined to entertain these

special leave petitions since they have been filed against the impugned interim orders passed by the High Court of Kerala in writ petitions.

However, we consider it appropriate in the interests of justice to pass the following order :

The petitioners shall receive fees upto Rs.11,00,000/- (Rupees eleven lakhs) from each student. Any student seeking admission will be obliged to pay fee of Rs.5,00,000/- (Rupees five lakh). As regards the rest of Rs.6,00,000/- (Rupees six lakh), the student may either furnish a bank guarantee for this balance amount or he/she may pay the said amount in cash. The petitioners shall keep this amount in a separate account and shall hold the said amount in that account till the disposal of the writ petitions by the High Court. It is also directed that the said amount and the bank guarantee shall be dealt with finally according to the orders of the High Court.

With the aforesaid directions, the special leave petitions are disposed of.
