O R D E R

Heard Mrs.Anjana Prakash, learned senior counsel for the petitioner and Mr.Maninder Singh, learned Additional Solicitor General for the Union of India and Mr.Gaurav Sharma, learned counsel for the respondent.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties, it is directed that the Medical Council of India shall conduct inspection as per the schedule for the academic year 2018-2019 in a time bound manner and if any deficiencies are found the same shall be intimated to the petitioner who shall also be afforded the opportunity to remove the

same as per regulation. After the deficiencies are removed the letter of permission would be granted. By the competent authority. Before any final decision is taken the Central Government shall consider the Oversight Committee that has been constituted as per the Constitution Bench decision in W.P.(C) No.408 of 2017 titled as "Amma Chandravati Educational and Charitable Trust & Ors. vs. Union of India & Anr." rendered on 18th July, 2017.

The earlier application that was filed by the institution shall be treated as application for the year 2018-2019. If the application was incomplete the petitioner-institution shall be allowed reasonable time to make it complete.

With the aforesaid observation, the writ petition stands disposed of. There shall be no order as to costs.
