O R D E R

By means of these two Transfer Petitions, the petitioner has prayed for transfer of pending cases from the 8th Additional District Judge, District Ahmedabad at Mirzapur, Ahmedabad, Gujarat and Additional Judge, Family Court, Dehradun, Uttarakhand to the District & Sessions Judge/Family Court, District Jaipur, Rajasthan. It is admitted by the parties that several other matters *inter se* parties are already transferred and pending at Jaipur before different courts.

Considering the contentions of the parties and the fact that there are several other matters pending at Jaipur, these two Transfer Petitions are also allowed.

Let Criminal Appeal No.26 of 2020 titled as "Sharad Anand Verma & Ors. Vs. the State of Gujarat & Anr." pending before the 8th Additional District Judge, District- Ahmedabad at

Mirzapur, Ahmedabad, Gujarat be transferred to District & Sessions Judge, Jaipur, Rajasthan and HMA No.202 of 2018 titled as "Mrs. Madhuri Verma vs. Mr. Sharad Verma" pending before Additional Judge, Family court, Dehradun, Uttrakhand, be transferred to District & Sessions Judge / Family Court, District Jaipur, Rajasthan.

Pending applications, if any, shall also stand disposed of.

Mr. D.N. Ray, learned counsel appearing for the respondent-husband has pointed out that a case relating to custody of the child is also pending before the Jaipur Court and it may be observed that the Court at Jaipur may deal with such matter and decide the same expeditiously as the father/husband is deprived of visitation rights and has not been allowed to meet his child. The request appears to be reasonable. The Family Court dealing with the custody of the child matter at Jaipur will make an endeavour to deal with the miscellaneous applications for visitation rights or for the custody of the child, as the case may be, expeditiously.
