O R D E R

The Petitioner and her mother have filed this Transfer Petition for transfer of the criminal case No. 26786 of 2017 arising out of FIR No. 617 of 2016 lodged by *Shashank Shekhar Singh* (husband of Petitioner No.1) pending before the Court in Bangaluru to a competent court in Lucknow.

Mr. Abhinav S. Raghuvanshi, learned counsel submits that the husband made false allegations against his wife and in laws before Bangaluru police. On the other hand, the counsel points out that four proceedings arising out of matrimonial dispute are pending before the Courts at Lucknow.

The Petitioner No.1-wife is unemployed and is dependant on her parents for her expenses and also for the requirement of her minor son since the interim maintenance paid by the husband is inadequate. The husband is projected to be an Engineer working in a MNC with good earning.
