ORDER

Leave granted.

The appellant has been implicated in a First Information Report dated 12 September 2018 alleging the commission of offences under Sections 324, 307, 332, 201 and 504 of the Indian Penal Code 1860. A charge-sheet has been submitted to the competent Court. The appellant is in custody since 9 November 2018.

On 31 July 2019, notice was issued by this Court and liberty was granted to serve the Standing Counsel appearing on behalf of State of Uttarakhand. The State of Uttarakhand is represented by Standing Counsel. On 11 September 2019, the following order was passed by this Court:

“...The petitioner is in custody since 9 November 2018. The FIR alleges commission of offences under Sections 332, 307, 504 and 201 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860.

Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, we direct that the petitioner be released on interim bail, subject to such terms and conditions as may be imposed by the Trial Court.

The State of Uttarakhand would be at liberty to file its counter affidavit within a period of four weeks from today.

List the Special Leave Petition thereafter.”

In the facts and circumstances of the case, we confirm the order dated 11 September 2019 by which the appellant was directed to be released on interim bail.

The appellant shall surrender her passport, if any, before the investigating officer and abide by the final direction of the trial court.

The appeal is accordingly disposed of.
