UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

- 1 Finding no error in the judgment of the High Court, we are not inclined to entertain the Special Leave Petition under Article 136 of the Constitution.
- 2 The Special Leave Petition is accordingly dismissed.
- 3 However, the parties should make a concerted effort to attempt a mediation to resolve the matrimonial dispute, having regard particularly to the welfare of their

two minor children. The parties shall appear before the Mediation Centre of the Delhi High Court on 25 November 2020 at 12 noon. We request Ms Sadhana Ramachandran to act as a Mediator.

- 4 Time to hand over possession of the premises in terms of the order of the High Court to the respondent is, on the request of the petitioner, extended until 17 December 2020. This extension is granted in view of the submission and at the request of Mr Mukul Rohtagi, learned Senior Counsel who sought some time to vacate for the petitioner on the ground that his ailing sister resides with him. No further extension shall be granted.
- 5 In the event that the parties arrive at a mediated settlement, the Mediator would be at liberty to forward the report of mediation before this Court so as to enable the Court to pass orders recording the terms of the settlement.
- 6 Pending application, if any, stands disposed of.
