O R D E R

There is no merit in this petition.

We are satisfied from the affidavit of the petitioners that they were admitted in April, 2017 and they appeared in the first professional examination in April, 2018. Whereas the first professional course is of the duration of two years and they further say that within six months they were to appear in the second professional examination which was to be held in February, 2019 and it has not been held so far.

The aforesaid makes it clear, course in question cannot be said to be even semblance of medical education course. We are satisfied that the remedy of the petitioners is only to seek refund of fees and/or compensation from the institution. They are not entitled of any indulgence of this Court in this matter.

The writ petition is dismissed.
