We are not inclined to interfere in this Special Leave Petition. The Special Leave Petition is dismissed accordingly.

However, we direct the concerned court to expedite the framing of charge, in the first place and if any

charge is framed against the petitioner, to proceed with the trial expeditiously. The prosecution is directed to ensure expeditious conclusion of trial. The trial be concluded, preferably within six months from today.

If any accused is not traceable, his trial can be separated and the matter be proceeded to conclude within six months, as aforesaid.

If the trial is not concluded within the time indicated above, the petitioner may apply for bail afresh which may be considered on its own merits, provided, there is nothing to show that the petitioner was responsible for delay in protracting the trial.
