UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

1. We have heard learned counsel for the parties.
2. The petitioners before this Court are wife and husband, respectively. Their marriage is opposed by the girl's father. Having a threat perception, they have approached the High Court by filing a Habeas Corpus petition. The petitioners before us challenges the order of the High Court and seeks to delete the direction contained in para-5 which directs the petitioners to go the Police Station at Panchkula where they have to interact with respondent Nos.4 and 5-Mother and Father of the Petitioner No.1-Sonia. Today, we have been informed that presently, the petitioners are residing happily as husband and wife in the southern region of the country. Deliberately, they are not disclosing their details due to the threat perception.
2. Considering, these new developments, we do not think that the direction contained in para-5 will be of any use at this juncture. Consequently, the direction contained in para-5 is set aside.
3. The Special Leave Leave Petition stands disposed of in the above terms.
