UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

This is a petition filed by 99 daily-wage employees working
with the Life Insurance Corporation of India with the following
prayers :

- "A. Issue a Writ of Mandamus or any other appropriate Writ, order or direction for regularisation of the services of the Petitioner temporary Class IV in the Life Insurance Corporation of India on a permanent basis along with all consequential benefits;
- B. Direct the Life Insurance Corporation of India to pay salary to the Petitioners according to the pay scale applicable to Permanent Peons till the disposal of the Writ Petition;

- C. Direct the Life Insurance Corporation of India to reinstate the Petitioners who have been removed from service;
- D. Pass such other order(s) as this Hon'ble Court may deem fit and proper in the facts and circumstances of the case."

This petition is being filed under Article 32 of the Constitution of India. In our view, in this extraordinary jurisdiction, we are not inclined to entertain this petition as disputed question of fact is involved.

The writ petition is dismissed with liberty to the petitioners to approach such other alternative forum available to them in law for redressal of their grievances.
