This transfer petition has been filed by the petitioner (wife) for transfer of the Divorce Case filed by the respondent (husband), pending before the Court of Principal Family Judge at Bangalore, Karnataka, to the Family Court at Hyderabad, Andhra Pradesh.

Heard Ms. Lakshmi Rao, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and Mr. Radhakrishna S. Hegde, learned counsel appearing for the respondent.

It is submitted that the petitioner is residing with her minor son in her parental home at Hyderabad. It further appears that the Divorce Case filed by the respondent was remanded back to the Trial Court for reconsideration by the High Court of Karnataka and the same is now pending before the concerned Court at Bangalore.

Having considered the pleadings and the submissions advanced on both sides, I deem it fit and proper to allow the transfer petition.

Accordingly, the M.C. No.2020 of 2015, titled as "*Mr. Srinivasulu Kyavars v. Ms. Lalitha Ratnam Kyavars*", pending before the Court of Principal Family Judge, Bangalore, Karnataka is transferred to the Family Court, Hyderabad, Andhra Pradesh.

Let the records of the case be transferred to the concerned court without delay.

With the above order, the Transfer Petition stands allowed.
