**UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following**  
**O R D E R**

- 1 Considering that six of the co-accused have been granted bail and another one, who had been arrested, has been granted bail, there could be no justification in refusing anticipatory bail to the petitioners. The disputes are essentially civil in nature. We, therefore, deem it appropriate to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners on the same conditions as contained in the order of the High Court dated 9 August 2019 in Criminal Miscellaneous

No.36033 of 2019. Needless to mention that the petitioners will be governed by the conditions for grant of anticipatory bail as contained in Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
