We find that notice was issued in this matter on 11-1-2021 but the State has failed to file its counter affidavit so far.

Heard learned counsel appearing for the petitioner, learned counsel appearing for the State of Bihar and carefully perused the material available on record.

Taking into consideration the fact that the petitioner is reported to be in jail for more than 1 year and 6 months and the fact that co-accused in the same P.S. Case No.30 of 2019 has already been released on bail by the High Court, we are inclined to enlarge him on bail.
