Learned counsel for the State of Bihar states that possession has already been handed over to the petitioner and in that respect, a Status Report has been filed.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner also admits that possession has been received by the petitioner. He, however, submits that the private respondents may be directed to file an affidavit that they will not interfere any further in the possession of the petitioner.

3. We are afraid that such a direction can be issued. It is for the petitioner to protect his possession and in case of any interference, to take appropriate proceedings before the Civil Court.

4. The contempt proceedings are accordingly closed. Notice is discharged.

5. The State of Bihar is at liberty to recover the cost incurred by it for handing over possession from the private respondents.

6. I.A. Nos.22443 of 2017 and 81049 of 2022 are disposed of accordingly.
