We are informed by learned counsel for the petitioner that the charge sheet has been filed. We are thus, of the view that appropriate recourse for the petitioner would be to apply for regular bail. The trial Court would consider the application of regular bail, which shall be filed within two weeks, keeping in mind the observations of this Court in *Siddharth v. State of Uttar Pradesh* - Criminal Appeal No.838/2021 decided on 16.08.2021

In the meantime, the petitioner be not arrested as he had throughout cooperated with the investigation, till the disposal of the application for regular bail. The trial Court will not be influenced by the conditions imposed as per the impugned orders which were for purposes of anticipatory bail.

The Special Leave Petition accordingly stands disposed of.
