UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following  
O R D E RSLP(Crl.) D. No.25045/2017 and SLP(Crl.) D.  
No.25449/2017 are counter cases, which was covered on  
24.06.2008.Learned Advocates on both sides submitted that the  
parties have compromised. The complainant in one matter (out  
of two matters) is the accused in another matter and vice  
versa. In order to live happily in future life, they want to

get the matter compromised.

Parties are stated to be family members. Affidavit is filed by Smt. Shakuntala W/o Bhandeppa Biradar in SLP(Crl.) D. No.25045/2017, which states that the parties have compromised and they do not want to continue the litigation. It seems that the parties have attained the age of 80 years and 75 years respectively and have injuries which are simple in nature.

It deems appropriate to permit the parties to compromise the matter. Accordingly, the order of High Court stands set aside.
