UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following  
O R D E R

I.A. No. 142212/2021 is an application seeking exemption from surrendering. The petitioner stands convicted in CC No. 1171 of 2009 for the offences punishable under Sections 279 and 304A of the Indian Penal Code and sentenced to undergo simple imprisonment for six months and to pay a fine of Rs. 3000/-and in default of payment of fine to undergo simple imprisonment for three months. In Criminal Appeal No. 19/2011, the learned Sessions Judge confirmed the conviction and the sentence. In Criminal Revision Petition No.

390/2012, the High Court of Karnataka at Bengaluru confirmed the conviction but modified the sentence of imprisonment to simple imprisonment for three months and thus allowed it in part.

Considering aforesaid circumstances and the fact that the petitioner is convicted under Section 304A IPC and sentenced to undergo only for a period of three months simple imprisonment, I am inclined to allow the above application.

Hence, the application stands allowed and the petitioner is exempted from surrendering.
