O R D E R

We have heard Mr. P.S.Narasimha, learned senior  
counsel appearing for the petitioners.

The High Court in exercise of its discretionary  
jurisdiction has directed the petitioner-TANGEDO to issue  
Appointment Order in favour of the first respondent-Mr.  
K.Ramalingam, S/o M.Kuzhanthaivelly. The High Court has

further clarified that if respondent No.1 is not inclined to join within the prescribed time as given in the Appointment Order, no further equity or benefit will accrue to him. The High Court has also clarified that the appointment is made in the peculiar facts and circumstances of the case and the direction to appoint will not in any way affect the merits of the contentions which may be raised by the petitioner-Corporation in such other cases and will not act as a precedent for such other cases at all.

In view of the above, we decline to entertain this petition. It is, accordingly, dismissed.
