O R D E R

Having given due consideration to the contentions by the parties, the averments made in the transfer petition, and in the interest of justice, the transfer petitions are allowed.

Accordingly, the Petition No. D-4 of 2020 titled "*Mukul Shriniwas Goyal vs. Nidhi Mukul Goyal*", pending before the Family Court, Solapur, Maharashtra is directed to be transferred to the Court of Presiding Officer, Family Court, Miyapur, Hyderabad, who may hear the case himself or assign it to a court of competent jurisdiction.

Records of the case would be immediately transferred to the Court of Presiding Officer, Family Court, Miyapur, Hyderabad.

To cut short delay, parties are directed to appear in-person or through the authorized representatives before the Presiding Officer, Family Court, Miyapur, Hyderabad, on 28.09.2022. In case there is non-appearance on behalf of the parties on the date fixed, court notice would be issued by the transferee court to the defaulting party.

The parties may explore the possibility of settlement through mediation. The transferee court would obtain the desire and wishes of the parties and proceed accordingly in this regard.

However, I am not inclined to transfer the Petition No. A-195 of 2020, which is for restitution of Conjugal Rights, titled "*Mukul Shrinivas Goyal vs. Nidhi Mukul Goyal*", which is pending before the Family court, Solapur, Maharashtra. Transfer petition with regard to this petition is dismissed.
