We have heard Ms. Geeta Luthra, learned senior counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner at length. She has taken us to the judgment and order passed by the High Court as well as the learned Special Court.

Having heard learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respective parties, we see no reason to interfere with the concurrent findings recorded by both the Courts below

holding the petitioner guilty for the offences under Sections 13(1)(e) and 13 (2) of the Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988. There are concurrent findings recorded by the courts below on appreciation of evidence that the petitioner was in possession of Rs.10,93,475/- which was found to be disproportionate to the known sources of income. Under the circumstances, the present Special Leave Petition stands dismissed.

Pending application(s), if any, shall stand disposed of.

Now, the petitioner to undergo the sentence. We grant four weeks time to the petitioner to surrender before the Competent Court having jurisdiction, to undergo the remaining sentence.
