Heard Mr. Mukesh Kr. Sharma learned counsel for the petitioner and Mr. Pavan Kumar, learned counsel for the respondent.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties, we are of the considered opinion that the proceedings initiated under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 forming the subject matter of HMA Petition No.45/2016 pending in the court of learned Additional District and Session Judge-1, Panchkula (Haryana) should be transferred to the district family court situate at Ajmer, Rajasthan with the direction to the learned family court to dispose of the same within six months hence.

It is ordered accordingly.

The transfer petitions stand disposed of.
