There are concurrent findings of fact recorded by all the courts below on the gift deed. The findings are on appreciation of evidence on record. Reliance placed upon some proceedings before the Tahsildar in support of the possession is neither here nor there. It is a settled proposition of law that mutation entries in the revenue record does not confer any right to title. As observed herein above, all the courts below have concurrently found against the petitioner and the gift deed has been dis-believed. Hence, Special Leave Petition stands dismissed.
