**UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R**

1. Delay condoned.
2. We are not inclined to interfere with the concurrent judgments of the Sessions Court and the High Court convicting the petitioner for murder under Section 302 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 and sentencing him to life in prison. Accordingly, the special leave petition stands dismissed.
3. However, since it is submitted that the petitioner has been in custody for more than 18 years without remission, we direct the Superintendent of the Correctional Home where he is lodged, to move the appropriate Department in the Government of Uttar Pradesh for securing his

premature release in accordance with the Remission Policy that is prevailing in such State and if he is found to be eligible for such release in terms thereof, we hope and trust that the Government shall take an appropriate decision as early as possible.

4. Pending interlocutory application(s), if any, stand disposed of.
