We have heard learned Additional Advocate General appearing for the State of U.P. and gone through the record.

There appears to be some substance in the contention of learned AAG that the anticipatory bail ought not to have been granted to the respondents – accused without hearing the State.

Taking into consideration the facts and circumstances of the case, particularly the fact that the respondents are senior citizens between the age group of 70 to 80 years, we are not inclined to interfere with the Impugned Orders passed by the High Court of Judicature at Allahabad, granting bail to the respondents.

The Special Leave Petitions are, accordingly, dismissed.
