This is a transfer petition at the instance of the petitioner-wife seeking transfer of O.P. No.345 of 2015, titled *Praveen Etta vs. Smt. Savitri Etta*, pending before the Family Court, City Civil Court at Secunderabad in Telangana, to the Family Court at Bellary, Karnataka.
