ORDER

This transfer petition has been filed by the petitioner-wife under Section 25 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908 seeking transfer of Marriage Petition No. 958/2020, titled as *“Mr. Rajkumar Natharam Choudhary Vs. Manju Ramnivas Jalwaniya alias Manju Vijay Khokhar alias Manju Rajkumar Choudhary”*, pending in the Court of Civil Judge (S.D.) Pune at Pune, Maharashtra to the Family Court No. 1, Jodhpur, Rajasthan.

Heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the material placed on record.
