O R D E R

Heard learned counsel for the petitioners as well as learned counsel for the contesting respondent nos.1 to 3.

In terms of the interim order passed by this Court on 08.10.2021, the petitioners have deposited a sum of Rs.5 lakhs with the Registry of this Court. A joint affidavit of the petitioners

and the contesting respondent nos.1 to 3 has been filed stating that the matter has been compromised between the parties and the respondent nos.1 to 3 may be permitted to withdraw the amount of Rs.5 lakhs deposited in this Court. As such, the parties have jointly stated that the matter be settled in terms of the compromise.

No one is present on behalf of respondent no.4. In any case, in our view, the said respondent no.4 is a formal party.

In view of the aforesaid, we direct that the respondents no.1 to 3 be permitted to withdraw the said amount of Rs.5 lakhs deposited with the Registry of this Court. Office report is ordered accordingly.

The special leave petition stands disposed of in terms of the joint affidavit of compromise filed by the petitioners and the contesting respondents no.1 to 3. No order as to costs.
