O R D E R

Delay condoned.

Though we are not inclined to interfere on the merits of the case yet we feel that the petitioners have been misguided into filing the various applications for passing supplementary award rather than filing an application under Section 18 of the Land Acquisition Act, 1894.

In the peculiar facts and circumstances of the case, we hereby

direct that in case the petitioners file a petition under Section 18 of the Act before the Reference Court within one month that should be treated to be in limitation and disposed of expeditiously in accordance with law. It is, however, made clear that the petitioners shall not be paid interest for the period of delay for which they are responsible.

The special leave petition stands disposed of. Pending applications stand disposed of.
