O R D E R

Heard Mr. Arvind P. Datar, learned senior counsel for the petitioner, the Maharashtra Cricket Association and Mr. Shyam Divan, learned senior counsel for the respondent, Shapoorji Pallonji and Co. Pvt. Ltd in S.L.P.(C) No.22616 of 2017.

Learned counsel for the parties very fairly agreed that they have no objection if Justice S.R. Sathe, formerly a Judge of the Bombay High Court, is appointed as sole Arbitrator and, accordingly, we nominate him as the Arbitrator. Needless to say, the learned Arbitrator shall proceed in accordance with law and all the issues are kept open. The bank guarantee that has already been furnished in this Court, shall be kept alive until further directions by this Court.

The special leave petition and the contempt petition stand disposed of accordingly. The interlocutory applications, if any, stands disposed of.

The parties are at liberty to move this Court for encashment of bank guarantee if occasion so demands.
