No. 504/2016, titled *Shri Lalitkumar Kalyani vs. Shrimati Neeta Kalyani*, pending before the Court of Family Magistrate, Ajmer, Rajasthan to the Family Court, Vadodara, Gujarat and (iii) H.M.P. No. 608/2016, titled *Shri Lalitkumar Kalyani vs. Shrimati Neeta Kalyani*, pending before the Court of Family Magistrate, Bhilwara, Rajasthan to the Family Court, Vadodara, Gujarat.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties and in view of the hardships which will be faced by the petitioner in contesting the cases at Ajmer and Bhilwara, we deem it proper to allow the transfer petitions and transfer the aforesaid cases to the Family Court, Vadodara, Gujarat, along with all records for their adjudication.

After transfer of the cases, the parties shall make a joint request for mediation before the concerned Family Court, which shall be dealt with by the Family Court in accordance with law.
