O R D E R

In the pending transfer petitions, the parties had been referred to the Supreme Court Mediation Centre to explore the possibility of settlement. The parties have thereafter agreed on certain terms for settlement in terms of Settlement Agreement dated 04.01.2023. As per the terms contained in paragraph 3 of the settlement, the amount agreed thereto is required to be paid by the respondent-Shri Ashok Kumar Singh to the petitioner-wife in the time frame referred therein. Subsequent thereto, the petitioner has agreed to withdraw the pending cases. In any event, the withdrawal of the cases would arise only after the monetary terms are settled.

In that view, at this stage, we see no reason to retain these petitions inasmuch the terms are to be complied between the parties whereupon the settlement would get finalized. Hence, on taking note of the settlement and making it a part of this order, the petitions are disposed of.

However, liberty is reserved to the parties to seek revival of the petitions if any of the terms remained to be complied and appropriate orders in that regard are required.
