O R D E R

Feeling aggrieved and dissatisfied with the impugned judgment and order dated 04-11-2020 passed by the High Court of Judicature at Bombay by which the High Court has rejected the anticipatory bail application filed by the petitioner, the original accused has preferred the present Special Leave Petition.

The present petition was heard earlier on 03.01.2022. Learned counsel appearing on both sides stated that the dispute between the parties is settled and the agreement is entered into between the parties. Time was sought for filing the appropriate
