



Constitution, the petitioner would pursue the remedies which are available in law, including by way of a petition under Section 482 of the CrPC for quashing. Mr Basant further states that the petitioner was granted time of three months to appear before the concerned criminal court since he is presently stationed abroad. He submits that the period may be extended or the petitioner may be exempted. It will be open to the petitioner to make the requisite application before the concerned court.
