O R D E R

- 1 The petitioner in person has forwarded an email dated 9 September 2020.
- 2 We have perused the record.
- 3 The petitioner withdrew a writ petition challenging the stoppage of one increment since a remedy of a departmental appeal is available to him. The writ appeal was also withdrawn before the High Court. By the impugned order dated 1 May 2020, the review petition has been dismissed.

- 4 In view of the previous order of the High Court permitting the withdrawal of the petition with liberty to file a departmental appeal, we are not inclined to entertain the Special Leave Petition under Article 136 of the Constitution, at this stage. However, in the event that the petitioner has filed a departmental appeal, we direct the appellate authority to expedite the disposal of the appeal. Moreover, all the rights and remedies of the petitioner to challenge the appellate order before the appropriate forum are kept open.
- 5 Subject to the aforesaid liberty, the Special Leave Petition is dismissed.
- 6 Pending applications stand disposed of.
