The petitioners are aggrieved since the High Court in exercise of its revisional jurisdiction has interfered with an order passed by the Sessions Judge. According to the High Court, at the stage of summoning on the basis of a protest complaint, the Sessions Judge ought not to have gone into the merits of the matter.

Be that as it may, at this stage we are not inclined to exercise our jurisdiction under Article 136 of the Constitution of India in the matter. The special leave petition is dismissed.

However, as and when the petitioners appear before the Trial Court, they shall be released on bail on execution of bond of Rs.25,000/- each with two solvent sureties.
