At the interim stage, in a pending First Appeal from a money decree in the sum of Rs.2,78,017/- with interest at the rate of 9% per annum, the High Court directed the petitioner to deposit the decretal sum along with interest and also granted liberty to the original plaintiff to prefer an appropriate application for withdrawal of the sum, which application would be decided on its own merits.
