O R D E R

This is a transfer petition at the instance of the petitioner-wife seeking transfer of M.C. No.5/2017, titled *Aniruddha Aditya vs. Debleena Datta*, pending before the court of Principal Civil Judge, Sr. Division, Rural District at Bangalore, Karnataka, to the court of District Judge, Burdwan, West Bengal.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties and in view of the hardships which will be faced by the petitioner in contesting the case at Bangalore, Karnataka, we deem it proper to allow the transfer petition and transfer the aforesaid case from the court of Principal Civil Judge, Sr. Division, Rural District at Bangalore, Karnataka to the Family Court at Calcutta, West Bengal, along with all records for its adjudication.

The respondent-husband shall pay a sum of Rs.50,000/- (Rupees fifty thousand only) to the petitioner-wife towards the litigation expenses within four weeks hence. Needless to say, after an appropriate application is filed under Section 24 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, it will be open to the Family Court Judge to pass appropriate orders. We may hasten to clarify that our grant of Rs.50,000/- is adhoc.

After transfer of the petition, the transferee Court is directed to make all endeavour either for amicable settlement or for early decision in the matter without unnecessary adjournments.
