O R D E R

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner.

This special leave petition has been filed against order dated 20.11.2020 passed by the High Court rejecting the application for anticipatory bail of the petitioner.

The petitioner is an accused in P.S. Case No. 41 of 2020 under Sections 498A, 323 and 307 of the Indian Penal Code.

This Court vide order dated 15.12.2020 stayed the arrest of the petitioner in P.S. Case No. 41/2020 and subsequently on 12.01.2021, it was observed that the matter be sent to the Mediation Centre of the district for making efforts for settlement between the parties.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the settlement has not been arrived at. He, further, submits that charge sheet has been filed, in which the petitioner has been charged and two other accused have been discharged.

Be that as it may, charge sheet has since been filed, it is open for the petitioner to make an application for regular bail before the Trial Court after surrendering. We also observe that the Trial Court shall consider the bail application expeditiously looking into the nature of allegation.

The special leave petition stands disposed of.
