It was observed that the commercial places were booked by the appellants purely for investment purposes and as such the appellants could not be considered to be consumers within the meaning of the Consumer Protection Act, 1986.

In the facts and circumstances on record, we see no reason to take a different view in the matter. Affirming the view taken by the National Commission, this Appeal is dismissed.
