O R D E R

When the matter is taken up, a compliance affidavit filed on behalf of the all the alleged contemnors (respondents 1 to 5) is brought to our notice wherein it is stated that pursuant to the earlier order of this Court dated 29.7.2016 in Civil appeal No.7176/2006, the cases of the appellants therein for upgradation of pay, were considered by the respondents and of the 29 appellants in the above mentioned appeal, 26 were found to be eligible for upgradation on an examination of the relevant facts and law and the cases of remaining three appellants whose names are specified in the affidavit are found to be not eligible for such upgradation.

Learned counsel for the petitioners in the contempt petition does not dispute the fact that the earlier directions of this Court in the above mentioned Civil Appeal have since been complied with insofar as 26 of the appellants are concerned, he only prays that in view of the conclusion of the respondents that three of the named appellants are not entitled for the benefit of the above

mentioned order of this Court, their liberty to question the conclusion of the respondents may be preserved.

In the circumstances, accepting the submission of learned counsel for the petitioners, the contempt petition is closed preserving the liberty of three appellants viz. Sri Man Mohan Kumar Sinha, Sri Kusheshwar Sharma and Sri Uma Shankar Pandey who were also appellants in the Civil Appeal No.7176/2016.
