ORDER

This Petition under Article 32 of the Constitution of India has sought transfer of investigation in connection with FIR No.787 of 2020 dated 21.10.2020 registered with Police Station Kotwali Orai, District-Jalaun, U.P. in respect of offences punishable under Sections 3(1)(g) and (d) of the SC/ST (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 and Sections 506, 406 and 383 IPC.

On the last occasion, learned counsel appearing for the parties had sought adjournment to seek appropriate instructions, if the parties could give a quietus to the proceedings initiated against each other.

We are happy to note that Mr. Alakh Alok Srivastava, learned advocate appearing for the petitioner and Mr. M.C. Dhingra, learned advocate appearing for Respondent No.2, after seeking appropriate instructions, have reported that cross proceedings initiated by the parties against each other be quashed.

In the circumstances, we deem it appropriate to direct:-

(a) Proceedings arising out of FIR No.0013 dated 09.01.2020 registered with Kishan Garh Police Station, District South-West, Delhi in connection with offences punishable under Sections 354(D), 506, 509 IPC and Section 67 of the Information Technology Act, 2000 are quashed.

(b) Proceedings arising out of FIR No.787 of 2020 dated 21.10.2020 registered with Police Station Kotwali Orai, District Jalaun, U.P. in connection with offences punishable under Sections 3(1)(g) and (d) of the SC/ST (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 and 506, 406 and 383 IPC are also quashed.

The parties agree to abide by the terms of settlement arrived at between them, copy of which is appended to the reply of respondent No.2.

This writ petition, thus, stands disposed of.
