O R D E R

The prayer of the applicant/petitioner to release him on bail in Session Trial No.40/2017, arising out of FIR No.458/2015 under Section 307 IPC was declined by this Court on February 16, 2021 after taking notice of the fact that only one witness left to be examined and the trial was near completion. A direction was consequently issued that the trial be concluded within a period of three months.

Learned counsel for the applicant/petitioner has brought to our notice the subsequent order dated 31.08.2021 whereby this Court again extended the period by one month to conclude the trial. Learned counsel submits that despite the above-stated extensions granted by this Court, the trial is still standstill and at the same stage.

Having heard learned counsel for the applicant/petitioner and taking into consideration the above-stated facts, we deem it appropriate to dispose of the instant application with a direction to the learned trial court to conclude the trial proceedings subject to cooperation from both sides on or before 31.12.2021. In the event of failure to do so, the applicant/petitioner shall be entitled to seek regular bail before the trial court and such an application shall be decided as per its own merit uninfluenced by the previous orders declining bail to him.

MA No.1799/2021 stands disposed of accordingly.

As a sequel to the above, pending interlocutory applications also stand disposed of.
