Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and also learned counsel for the respondent (complainant).

The learned counsel jointly referred to the Memorandum of Settlement arrived through the efforts of the Bangalore Mediation Centre and point out that in terms of the the said settlement, the parties have agreed to withdraw the case(s) filed against each other. Furthermore, it is pointed out that for the upkeep, sustenance, education and other requirements of the minor child (*Mohd. Hatim*), those shall be born by the respondents collectively. Accordingly, twelve post dated cheques of Rs.25,000/- each totaling Rs.3,00,000/- in favour of 'Qurratulain Latif' is drawn on *Saraswat Bank Pali Hill Road Branch, Khar Mumbai* and those cheques are required to be handed over by the respondent No.1 to the mother of the child.

In view of the above, we permit to hand over the cheques mentioned in the settlement agreement and the same are allowed to be utilized in the manner recorded in the settlement. It is ordered accordingly.

With the above order, the transfer petition stands disposed of. The settlement agreement is made a part of this Court's order.
