O R D E R

While allowing the Second Appeal, the High Court made the following observations:-

"In the present case, judgment and decree was passed on 04.02.1988. In the revenue record, the judgment and decree was incorporated vide mutation sanctioned on 12.12.1988. The present suit was filed on 11.04.2008 after a period of more than 19 years. The plea of the plaintiffs that they did not come to know of the decree cannot be accepted particularly when in the revenue record, defendant No.1 was being depicted as absolute owner of the property. Still further, Hans Raj was died in the year 1994. On his death, even if the plaintiffs were not in knowledge of the decree prior to the death of Hans Raj, at least they would have made endeavour to get the mutation sanctioned in their favour and consulted revenue officials. Therefore, the case set up by the plaintiffs is also not believable."

The challenge to the decision of the High Court was found to be without any merit and the Special Leave Petitions were dismissed by this Court.

We have gone through the contents of the Review Petitions and do not find any substance or merit in Review Jurisdiction.

These Review Petitions are, therefore, dismissed.
