O R D E R

The Court is convened through Video Conferencing.

The petitioner (wife) seeks transfer of Divorce Petition, M.C. No.2073/2020 titled as "Rohit Vardhan G. vs. Madhuri Nagaraj" filed by the respondent (husband) under Section 13 (1) (i-a) of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 pending in the Court of Principal Judge, Family Court at Bengaluru, Karnataka to the Family Court at Krishnagiri District, Tamil Nadu.

The marriage was solemnized between the parties on 19-8-2018 and no child is born out of wed-lock.

Notice was issued on this Transfer Petition on 22-2-2021 and further proceedings were stayed.

As per the Office Report, the respondent (husband) has been duly served.

When the matter was called out, neither the respondent appeared in-person nor through an Advocate.

Taking into consideration the attending circumstances and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the Divorce Petition bearing M.C. No.2073/2020 titled as "Rohit Vardhan

The records shall be transferred to the transferee Court forthwith.
