

the proceedings have been adjourned to 2 March 2022 so that the main matter can be taken up for final disposal.

- 2 We have heard Ms Vibha Datta Makhija, learned senior counsel in support of the applicant.
- 3 The purport of the order of this Court dated 2 March 2021 was to ensure the expeditious disposal of the application for vacating stay. The learned Single Judge has simply adjourned the proceedings on 25 October 2021 so that the main matter can be disposed of on 2 March 2022.
- 4 We permit the applicant to move the learned Chief Justice of the High Court of Punjab & Haryana to assign a Bench for hearing the proceedings so that the order of this Court dated 2 March 2021 is complied with. In the event that the learned Single Judge is in a position to dispose of the proceedings completely at the stage of final hearing, the Court is at liberty to do so by 31 January 2022. If due to the exigencies of the work, it is not possible to dispose of the proceedings finally, the application for vacating stay shall, in any event, be taken up and be disposed of within the said period.
- 5 A copy of this order shall be communicated to the Registrar (Judicial) of the High Court so that necessary steps can be taken on the administrative side.
- 6 The Miscellaneous Application is disposed of.
- 7 Pending applications, if any, stand disposed of.
