O R D E R

1. During the pendency of this transfer petition, the matter was referred to the Supreme Court Mediation Center to explore the possibility of an amicable settlement between the parties.
2. In the said process, a Settlement Agreement dated 30<sup>th</sup> May, 2022 has been entered into between the parties, wherein they have among other terms agreed that their marital relationship is to be brought to an end.
3. The learned counsel for the parties submit that the other terms which were agreed in the said Settlement Agreement, have been complied with and they are mutually satisfied with the settlement, which has been adhered to by the parties.
4. In that light, on taking note that the parties have been litigating with each other from the year 2019, and since the

marriage has been irretrievably broken down with absolutely no scope for reconciliation, we deem it appropriate to invoke and exercise our jurisdiction under Article 142 of the Constitution of India and dissolve the marriage between the parties, which was performed on 12.05.2014 so as to serve the ends of justice.

5. In that view, this Order shall be taken note in the Petition No. A 472 of 2019, titled as "*Rahul Dewan Vs. Niti Singla*" pending before the Family Court of Thane, Maharashtra and the matter be disposed of in terms of this Order.

6. The petition is accordingly, disposed of.

7. Pending application(s), if any, shall stand disposed of.
