O R D E R

1. The instant petition has been preferred by the petitioner under Article 32 of the Constitution seeking transfer of case to the CBI for an independent inquiry.
2. Heard learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner as also learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondent - State.
3. During the course of the hearing, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in spite of repeated requests made by the counsel for the petitioner, the petitioner's bail application registered as Criminal Bail Application No. 2078/2021 which is pending consideration before the High Court, has not been taken up for hearing.

4. In view of the above, we request the Chief Justice of the Bombay High Court to take up the matter either by himself or by any Judge nominated by him and dispose of the same expeditiously in accordance with law, preferable within a period of four weeks.

5. Liberty is also granted to the petitioner to mention the said bail application before the Chief Justice of the Bombay High Court for early hearing of the matter.

6. The writ petition stands disposed of accordingly.

7. As a sequel to the above, pending interlocutory applications also stand disposed of.
