O R D E R

Heard Mr. Anand Chichra, learned counsel appearing for the Petitioner (plaintiff) and the appellant in the RFA (OS) No.9/2016 before the Delhi High Court. The counsel submits that First Appeal is posted for final argument on 14.03.2024 and the appellant has already filed their written argument.

2. The present matters arise out of the interim order dated 31.10.2018 & 16.07.2019 in the pending RFA. The execution proceeding was stayed by this Court on 30.08.2019 while issuing notice in the SLP.

3. Taking note of the aforesaid development on the concluding stage of the First Appeal before the High Court, and the long continuation of the stay of execution since 30.08.2019, we deem it appropriate to say that this Court's interim order will continue until the conclusion of the first appeal. It is ordered accordingly.

4. The Special Leave Petitions are disposed of with the observation that the pending First Appeal should be decided on its own merit. Pending application(s), if any, stand closed.
