We are not inclined to interfere in this  
special leave petition.

However, as requested by the petitioners  
through counsel, we grant time to vacate the suit  
premises till 30<sup>th</sup> June, 2020 subject to furnishing  
usual undertaking before this Court within two  
weeks from today, stating that the petitioners will  
not create any third party rights, will pay the

outstanding dues, as on today, within four weeks from today and shall continue to pay compensation at the rate of Rs.50,000/- (Rupees fifty thousand only) per month from 1<sup>st</sup> August, 2019 till the petitioners peacefully vacate the suit premises on or before 30<sup>th</sup> June, 2020.

We make it clear that issue regarding the quantum of outstanding dues be decided by the Executing Court on its own merits in accordance with law.

The special leave petition and pending application(s) are accordingly disposed of.
